COMITÉ-CONSEIL SUR L'ÉVALUATION DES RESSOURCES DIDACTIQUES

The *Comité-conseil sur l'évaluation des ressources didactiques* (CCERD) is a consulting committee that plays a role in approving instructional materials through the following mandates that were assigned to it by the Minister:

- to recommend the Minister's approval of instructional materials, based on analyses carried out by the BAMD
- to advise the Minister on any matter related to the evaluation, approval, implementation and review of instructional materials

The CCERD is made up of thirteen members appointed by the Minister. Nine of these are associated with the education system (French and English sectors; public and private sectors; elementary and secondary levels), one member is from the university community, two members are parents of students and one member represents the publishing companies affiliated with l'Association nationale des éditeurs de livres (ANEL).

ALLOTMENT OF RESPONSIBILITIES

The rights and responsibilities of school boards, of private schools and of the Minister with respect to instructional materials used in the schools are defined in the *Education Act*.

According to the *Education Act*, the Minister ["may draw up a list of textbooks and instructional material or classes of instructional material approved by him"] (R.S.Q., c. I-13.3, s. 462).

The school board or private school ["shall ensure that only the textbooks, instructional material or class of instructional material approved by the Minister"] are used for the teaching of any program of studies established by the Minister (R.S.Q., c. I-13.3, s. 230 and c. E.-9.1, s. 35). Since the list of approved instructional materials includes only "*basic instructional materials*," the obligation applies to this type of materials only.

"The principal is responsible for approving, on the proposal of the teachers or, in the case of matters referred to in subparagraph 5, of the members of the staff concerned and after consulting with the governing board in the case of proposals under subparagraph 3,...

(3) in accordance with this Act and in keeping with the school budget, the textbooks and instructional material required for the teaching of programs of studies." (R.S.Q., c. I-13.3, s. 96.15.)

"Students other than those enrolled in adult education have a right to the free use of textbooks and other instructional material required for the teaching of programs of studies until the last day of the school calendar of the school year in which they reach 18 years of age, or 21 years of age in the case of handicapped persons within the meaning of the Act to secure the handicapped in the exercise of their rights (c. E-20.1). Each student shall have the personal use of the textbook chosen pursuant to section 96.15 for each compulsory and elective subject in which the student receives instruction." (R.S.Q., c. I-13.3, s. 7.)

DEFINITIONS

The *Education Act* states that the Minister may approve works that are indispensable to preschool, elementary and secondary education, i.e. "*basic instructional materials*" and which include instructional packages and reference works for classroom use.

Instructional Packages

Instructional packages:

- are designed specifically for children in preschool or for students in elementary or secondary school;
- consist of at least two components that form an integrated unit: the student's textbook and a teacher's guide intended to assist teachers in their pedagogical approach;
- propose sufficient means (related content, activities and exercises) to enable the students to attain the compulsory objectives as stated in programs of study;
- may include other elements, such as materials that may be reproduced or classroom materials, but never consumable materials.

Reference Works for Classroom Use

The following reference works, which are used on a regular basis in the classroom, are also considered basic instructional materials: dictionaries, grammars, atlases and bibles.

Other Types of Instructional Materials

Works that are not considered basic instructional materials may be used without the specific approval of the Minister. Thus, complementary materials (which covers only certain objectives of a program), as well as most reference works, literary works, songbooks or musical repertoires are not subject to approval by the Minister. Each school board must put into place its own means of evaluating and selecting these materials.

Despite the fact that exercise books may be used daily in the classroom, they are not be considered basic materials and thus are not subject to approval by the Minister. Consequently, they are neither endorsed nor prohibited by him. As with all complementary materials, each school board is responsible for analyzing them as necessary and for making the decision as to whether or not these materials are relevant to its students. "Instructional packages" approved by the Minister are complete in themselves and include sufficient exercises to eliminate the need for separate exercise books. In public school teaching, students have the right to free instructional materials, but this right "does not extend to documents in which students write, draw or cut out." (R.S.Q., c. I-13.3, s. 7.)

CRITERIA

There are 17 criteria on which the Ministère bases its evaluation of instructional materials. These criteria are grouped under three headings: PEDAGOGY, PRESENTATION and VALUES AND STANDARDS.

PEDAGOGY

LEARNING PROCESS

The materials should include means that correspond to the orientations or guiding principles of the program.

CONTENT

The materials should include means that enable the students to develop the competencies or achieve the objectives of the program.

EVALUATION

The materials should include formative evaluation methods that are related to the learning activities selected in accordance with the orientations and content of the program.

ACCURACY

The materials should include accurate, objective and up-to-date content.

PRACTICALITY

The materials should include means designed to facilitate teaching practices.

CLASSROOM MANAGEMENT

The materials should include means designed to facilitate classroom organization.

RESOURCES

The materials should propose means that take into account both the teaching time allotted to the program and the available resources.

ADAPTATION

The materials should propose means that are adapted to the student's needs and that favour cultural development.

PRESENTATION

PRINTING

The materials should be well constructed (i.e. quality of paper, composition and print).

LAYOUT

The materials should be functional and attractive (i.e. quality of layout, illustrations, and means used to find information).

VALUES AND STANDARDS

- The materials should be consonant with moral and religious values.
- The materials should conform to the rules regarding the elimination of discriminatory stereotypes.
- The materials should conform to the rules of standard language usage.
- The materials should conform to the laws and regulations that govern advertising directed at children.
- The materials should conform to the rules and conventions for writing place names.
- The materials should conform to occupational health and safety rules.
- The materials should conform to the rules and conventions regarding SI units and other standards for style.

PERIOD OF APPROVAL

Instructional Packages

The approval of instructional packages remains valid as long as the program is in effect. The period of approval may be limited, however, when it is desirable to update the information contained in the material.

Reference Works for Classroom Use

Reference works for classroom use such as dictionaries are approved for a period of 7 years.

COPYRIGHT

The works listed on the Exclusion List published by the Société québécoise de gestion collective des droits de reproduction (COPIBEC) are protected under the *Copyright Act*, which prohibits reproduction in any form, adaptation or modification, in whole or in part, unless prior authorization has been obtained from the person holding the copyright, usually the publisher.

However, this does not apply in cases where notices appearing in the works authorize teachers to reproduce certain parts or certain pages of specific materials, some of which can be removed.

Moreover, an agreement drawn up between COPIBEC and the Ministère de l'Éducation du Québec allows teachers to reproduce certain works within certain limitations and under certain conditions.

Before reproducing any work, it is thus important to:

1. make sure it does not appear on COPIBEC's Exclusion List
2. respect the conditions set out in the reproduction agreement
